Easter Weekend the club had been invited to join our sister club from Las Vegas on a trip to Tonopah. Unfortunately I do not think anyone was able to go. Our weather was pretty crummy on Saturday. Fortunately for us a few members have been on trips to Tonopah and here are their stories.

Back in the 50's (yes some of us are old enough to remember them) the Nevada

Sports Touring Association (NSTA), which later became the SCCA club, would meet up at the old Army Air Corp training camp with the Las Vegas Club just east of Tonopah and hold a gymkhana on the old airfield. Today part of the airport still exists, with several old hangar buildings still standing. Anyhow, we all camped out at the airfield and had a great time. I still had my Austin Healey and did pretty good if I do say so myself (I can say that as none of you current members were there!) We did this for two or three years, but it went by the wayside for some reason of which I do not know. I was living in Alaska shortly after the last meet, so I wasn't around to find out why it stopped. It is nearly right in the middle of the two cities, 3 hrs 44 min from Reno (modern speeds as shown on Google Maps) and 3 hrs 12 min from Las Vegas. That's 228 miles from Reno. Got to add time, as our group could probably



travel 60 mph, not the posted 70. did some math, looks like Google used 65 as a guide for time, so it would still be less than 4 hours at 60. Belmont, ghost town' about 50 minutes from Tonopah, is a terrific spot to visit. The Courthouse is a famous place. All paved roads.

last year as our first trip following Covid. We had a good time. The Mizpah seemed nice. The Mizpah restaurant served simple food but it was very good, including a great breakfast. Maybe the best hamburger I have ever had. We had another dinner there and as I recall it was very good too. The bar was nice and poured generous drinks.

We stayed across the street at the Belvada Hotel. It is a very fresh total rebuild of a 6-story hotel creating a boutique hotel experience that would stand up in any major city right there in Tonopah. There is a BBQ restaurant a few blocks from the hotels. We found the craft beer to be very good but the food there was just OK. Being southerners, BBQ has to be good to get our attention. A Corvette club on their way to drive Route 66 showed up when we were in this restaurant. They were staying at the two story motel across from the restaurant. Though the staff was stressed, they got everyone served.

The Mizpah, Belvada and BBQ place are all owned by an apparently very rich couple that has decided to revitalize Tonopah. They are not sparing any expense and this has created some cool venues.

To the south in Goldfield there is a folk-art exhibit of old cars, trucks and busses planted in the ground and painted in bright paint. Kind of a neat side show. There is a historic WW2 airfield nearby off to the east that was fun to visit. Nothing formal there, just cool. There are a couple of "ghost towns" within 30 miles or so that are a fun daytrip.
