# Tech Session

## Saturday, April 18th

### At David Doyle Shop

I arrived early at David Doyles place for the TVR tech session to check on the set-up. There were plenty of doughnuts and coffee so we were good to go. David has been busy working on his new shop, which I had an opportunity to tour, it is spacious enough for a couple of Class A RV's and is nearing completion.

We had a great turnout with plenty of help and even more to advice. The TVR's engine was stuck by something related to installing the transmission, 5 speed, 5 speed adapter-plate, clutch or flywheel. David's friend Matt put a big breaker bar on the damper nut to turn the engine, then Peter and I started taking parts off. We removed the starter and had no luck turning the engine over. We kept David busy finding tools and went on to removing the drive line and loosening the transmission. When the transmission bolts were removed the engine would rotate. Washers placed on the lower transmission bolts between the transmission and adaptor-plate eliminated binding and allowed the engine to rotate freely. This is a temporary fix that will allow David to continue assembling and perhaps to start up the TVR. Thanks to everyone for attending, see you next time.



# TMCC Tour

Wyatt Ziebell, the lead instructor, conducted an engaging one-hour tour of the TMCC Applied Technologies department at their Edison Way campus. The tour was very interactive, featuring numerous questions and answers as participants explored the Auto, Diesel, Welding, Machining, and Advanced Manufacturing programs.

The Auto program is designed to prepare students for careers as Auto Technicians, Service Writers, Managers, and more. Through coursework, students prepare for ASE (Automotive Service Excellence) certifications, as well as Associate's and Bachelor's degrees. The course curriculum includes a general auto maintenance prerequisite (Auto 101), followed by advanced classes that includes three Electrical classes, two on Engine Performance (covering engine/system diagnosis and repair), an Engine Repair/Rebuilding class, a Steering and Suspension course, and a Brake course. Additionally, there are numerous elective courses the students can choose. For further details, please refer to the course description link below.

We were able to see the impressive assortment of equipment across all of their programs, specifically within their Auto Program. There were new tire machines and spin balancers, a new alignment rack, a new dynamometer, new Snap-On toolboxes, latest Snap-On Zeus, and Varis diagnostic instruments (bi-directional code scanner/oscilloscope combination tools) and Fluke meters just to name a few.

RBCC members displayed 11 cars at the event, which included a broad swath of vehicles from classic to modern models. The students were able to view vehicles that included a Sunbeam Tiger, a Triumph GT6, an MGB, an MGBGT, an MG 1100, a Jensen Healey, a Mini Cooper, a Jaguar F Type, a Lotus Evora, an Aston Martin, and a McLaren. Many students and instructors from the program came down to look at the vehicles; many of these students and instructors did not have the knowledge or experience with our British cars. Wyatt was joined by other instructors including Roger Stressman and Eric Lindesmith.

I thought this tour would be well received and it appears to have been!

I wanted to mention that I have been participating in the TMCC Auto program for a year and a half. As a student, I have been very impressed with the program myself. This includes the quality of instruction, the coursework, the equipment students get trained to use etc. I have been so impressed that my wife and I recently set up an ongoing scholarship to help students in need afford the program as many of them struggle and work while also going to school.
