

"The Reno British Car Club Saved the Day"

Tuesday night Peter got a frantic email from Rick and Sherilynn Casey who were stranded in Reno with their TR3. They were on their way home from Triumphest in Flagstaff, AZ to Olympia, WA, when they realized that they had a front wheel bearing problem. Peter had him get in contact with some shops, but all were busy. Peter threw club members Dennis and Andy under the bus and recommended that they call Dennis and/or Andy, they might be able to help him.

The following is Dennis' an account of being a Good Samaritian.

"I told Peter that I would send him a sequence of events on how well the Club took car of Rick and Sherilynn Casey and his Triumph TR3 front wheel bearing problem.

I received a call from Rick Casey on Wed. 10/21/21 at 8am who was on his way home from Triumphest in flagstaff, AZ to Olympia, WA. He told me that he stopped driving his Triumph TR3 20 miles before reaching Reno due to a front wheel bearing problem and had it towed to Reno. I told him that I had a complete set of front wheel bearings for his car and a car hoist at my house so please bring his car on over.

He had the car towed to my place and arrived about 1 pm and we put the car on the hoist. In trying to take off the wheel hub, we found out that the outer bearing was frozen on the front axle.

We used an air grinder to pull out the loose bearings so we could remove the front wheel hub. We removed the axel and ground off the frozen bearing and had my next-door neighbor who has a lathe machine it back to its original shape.

In searching for a replacement axle, I called Andy Killian and he told me that he given Peter Gulash an axle, so I called Peter and he supplied us with a used axle. We used the good used axle due to not knowing how good the re-machined one would be. We reassembled the front wheel hub with a new set of bearings and repacked the other front wheel. Due to working late that evening, we the car out the next morning for a test drive to make sure everything was running well. After rechecking and readjusting the wheel bearing end play, he was on his way.

When Rick got to Klamath, OR he called and said everything was running fine. I asked him to let me know how his trip went when he got home and he said he would. I made some new friends in Olympia, WA and it did not cost him anything for the repairs."
